President Stone called the meeting to order at 3:17 p.m.

II. APPROVE THE MINUTES

Mrs. Hart moved, seconded by Mrs. Poehling, to accept the minutes of the December 11, 2023 Committee of the Whole meeting. The minutes were approved as submitted by **General Consent**.

IV. SCHOOL FINANCE COMMITTEE (SFC) ITEMS

A. KEEP39 Additional Information

The Board reviewed and discussed KEEP39 fee options for the 2024-2025 school year. Mr. Bultemeier presented each scenario based on different fee proposals. The following options were presented:

- 1. Option 1 \$6,460 per student fee (baseline assumption info, used as a reference point)
- 2. Option 2 \$4,392 per student fee (covers 100% of estimated operational costs)
- 3. Option 3 \$3,230 per student fee (cuts fee in half, Board subsidy at 26.5%) 40.35% for 3 years or for one year 38.21%

For each option, the Board was presented with the 5-year projections. The projections provided outlooks for charging the fee for one more year and for charging the fee for three more years. The Board elected to move forward with a motion to approve the fee at \$3,230 per student for next year and to recommend the administration plan to implement full-day kindergarten for the 2025-2026 school year.

B. Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Calendar and ResolutionMr. Bultemeier presented the fiscal year 2025 budget calendar and guidelines.

A. Goal 2 Action Step – Foundations Update
